STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 26* FOR ANSWER ON 24.07.2023 ASKED BY SHRI NARHARI AMIN REGARDING 'ONE STOP CENTRE SCHEME'

- (a) & (b): The One Stop Centre (OSC) scheme is being implemented by the Government since 1st April, 2015 to provide integrated support and assistance under one roof to women affected by violence and those in distress, both in private and public spaces and also to provide an integrated range of services including medical aid, legal aid and advice, temporary shelter, police assistance, psycho-social counselling to needy women. So far, 816 One Stop Centres have been approved in all 36 States/UTs, out of which 785 OSCs are operational.
- (c): Number of cases registered in the country through One Stop Centres during last two years are as under:-
