(a): Bureau of Civil Aviation Security (BCAS), the aviation security regulator of India, has issued the latest order setting the timeline for installation of Full Body Scanners (FBS) at IGI airport, Delhi as June, 2024.

(b): The timeline for installation of FBS changed due to evolving technical specifications and Standard Operating Procedure, based on trials conducted at IGI airport, Delhi by BCAS.
