#### Expansion of fishing harbour in Kerala

#### 1008 Shri Haris Beeran:

Will the Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying be pleased to state :

- (a) whether the State Government of Kerala has submitted project proposals for expansion of fishing harbour in the State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, and
- (c) the action taken by Union Government in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH ALIAS LALAN SINGH)

(a) to (c): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying is implementing a flagship scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) with an investment of Rs. 20,050 crore for a period of 5 years with effect from Financial Year 2020-21 to 2024-25 for holistic development of fisheries in all States/UTs including Kerala. Further, in order to address the infrastructure requirement for fisheries sector, the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying during 2018-19 created a dedicated fund namely Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) with a total funds size of Rs 7522.48 crore. The FIDF provides concessional finance to the Eligible Entities (EEs) including State Governments/Union Territories and State entities for development of identified fisheries infrastructure facilities including fishing harbours and fish landing centres.

The Development of fishing harbours and fish landing centres is one of the important areas envisaged and supported under PMMSY/FIDF implemented by the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying. Such fisheries infrastructure projects are approved based on submission of technically and financially viable proposals by the project proponent.

The State Government of Kerala during the last three financial years (2020-21) to (2023-24) has submitted 10 number of technically and financially viable project proposals for expansion/modernization/dredging of fishing harbours to the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying for financial assistance under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) and the same have been accorded approval at a total cost of Rs 161.11 crore. Further, the Department of Fisheries, Government of India has also accorded approval to the proposal of Cochin Port Authority for modernization and upgradation of Cochin fishing harbour at Thoppumpady in Kerala at a cost of Rs 169.17 crore under Central Sector component of PMMSY. The details of these approved projects are furnished at Annexure-I. In addition, the Department of Fisheries, Government of India has also accorded approval to the proposal of Government of Kerala for construction of a new fishing harbour at Arthunkal in Alappuzha District, Kerala at a cost of Rs 161.00 Crore for concessional financing in the form of interest subvention up to 3% on the loan amount under Fisheries and Aquaculture Infrastructure Development Fund (FIDF) Scheme.
