VACANCIES IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ATOMIC ENERGY

1122. SHRI R. GIRIRAJAN

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government has taken adequate steps to fill up the vacancies falling under the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the incumbency position as on 1st July, 2024 in respect of all the DAE organisations, Aided Institutes, all Public Sector Undertakings under the aegis of DAE; and
- (c) whether Government has initiated any special recruitment drive for filling up of vacancies in SC/ST/OBC and Minority communities and if so, the details thereof, if not, the reasons therefor?

- (a) Yes. The Department has taken adequate steps to fill up 9263 vacant posts.
- (b) The incumbency position as on 1st July, 2024 in respect of Department of Atomic Energy is as follows:

DAE & its Constituent Units	29037
Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)	17240
Aided Institutions (AIs)	8983
Total	55260

- (c) Yes, special recruitment drive was conducted for filling up 07 (seven) SC, 24 (twenty four) ST and 11 (eleven) OBC vacancies.
