(a) to (d): The Public Enterprises Survey, which is conducted by Department of Public Enterprises, Ministry of Finance, provides yearwise number of Regular Employees, Casual / daily Rate workers and Contract Workers/Employees in Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs). As per the data in latest Public Enterprises Survey 2022-23, CPSEs across sectors employed 14.90 lakh persons as of financial year 2022-23 including minorities.
