**PROJECTS UNDER PM GATI SHAKTI NATIONAL MASTER PLAN IN ANDHRA
PRADESH**

1316 SHRI V. VIJAYASAI REDDY:

Will the Minister of **Commerce and Industry** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether 13 projects with an estimated cost of ₹5,800 crores under PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan were taken up in the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) if so, the details of each of the above projects including objectives, cost outlay and estimated timeline of completion, project-wise;
- (c) whether any of the requisite funds has been released; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY
(SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

- (a): For enhanced capital expenditure by States for infrastructure development, the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure under Part-II (for PM GatiShakti related expenditure of “Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment for 2022-23”) had made provision of Rs. 5000 Crore total for disbursement among all the States as long-term loans including the state of Andhra Pradesh. 2 projects worth of Rs. 202.00 crores had been approved for Andhra Pradesh.
- (b): Details of the 2 Projects worth of Rs 202 Crores which were approved for Andhra Pradesh under Special Assistance Scheme Part- II for the year 2022-23 are as under:

1. Phase I of 46 MLD External Water Supply to Jagananna Mega Industrial Hub (JMIH) :

Project serves as an integrated approach to planning for development of Kopparthu node of Vishakhapatnam, Chennai Industrial Corridor for water connectivity, with estimated cost at Rs 171 Crore. Currently 20% of the project work is completed.

2. Project II : Railway siding to YSR JMIH, Kopparthu, Kadapa

It is a connectivity project for faster movement of goods from Industrial units in Kopparthu node under Vizag Chennai Industrial corridor, YSR Jagananna Mega Ind Hub, YSR EMC & proposed PM Mitra Park, with estimated Project costs at Rs. 54 Crore. Currently 45% of the work of the project is completed.

(c) & (d): Under this scheme, two Projects have been approved and fund released by the Department of Expenditure viz (i) Phase I of 46 MLD External Water Supply to Jagananna Mega Industrial Hub (JMIH) (ii) Railway siding to YSR JMIH, Kopparthu, Kadapa with allocation of Rs 171 Crore and Rs 31 Crore respectively.
