- (d) the details of special plan being considered by Government to facilitate passengers intending to visit Bihar on the eve of 'Chhath' festival?

(a) to (d) On Indian Railways, demand of reserved accommodation in trains is not uniform throughout the year and it varies over lean and peak periods and also during different days of the week. During peak rush periods like Holi, Diwali, Chhath & summers etc., the demand for reserved accommodation is high as trains running on high density sectors are well patronised. To cater to this additional demand and in its constant endeavour to provide additional accommodation to travelling passengers, IR operates Special train services during festivals, holidays, etc. and augments the load of trains both on permanent and temporary basis. These are on-going processes on Indian Railways. Details of special trains operated to cater to extra demand during the Holi, Summer vacations and Chhath in the years 2022, 2023 & 2024 are as under:-
