INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT STATUS TO JAMNAGAR AIRFIELD

(a) whether the airfield at Jamnagar, Gujarat, was provided temporary international airport status and allowed to operate international flights between 25th February to 5th March, 2024; and

(b) if so, the grounds for designating it as such thereof?

(a) & (b): Jamnagar Airport belongs to Indian Air Force (IAF), where Airports Authority of India (AAI) operates a Civil Enclave. As a Joint User Airfield, Jamnagar Airport has regular operations of scheduled and non-scheduled civil aircraft (domestic and international). The international non-scheduled flights, which operated at Jamnagar during the said period, were cleared by Ministry of Defence as per their extant policy.
