(a) & (b): Yes, in total 10 biometric kiosks are installed in pre-immigration area in arrival zone in Indira Gandhi International Airport, Terminal-3, New Delhi by Ministry of Home Affairs.

(c): The programme aims to facilitate faster immigration clearance and reduce congestion at immigration counters.

(d) to (f): Yes, all major Airport Operators can install Biometric Enrollment Kiosks in their pre-immigration areas in the arrival zone. The kiosks are being installed by the Airport Operators to improve the overall passenger experience.
