SMART CITIES MISSION

1490. SHRI R. DHARMAR:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the feature of the Smart Cities Mission;
- (b) details of the funds allocated and utilized under this mission in Tamil Nadu, district-wise in the last four years;
- (c) details of the projects approved under this mission within Tamil Nadu so far;
- (d) details of the projects completed and the projects which are in advance stage of completion within Tamil Nadu;
- (e) details of the key achievements under this mission within Tamil Nadu so far; and
- (f) whether this mission has been a beacon of urban transformation, enhancing the quality of life across the country, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

- (a) As stated in the Smart Cities Mission Guidelines, some typical features of comprehensive development in Smart Cities include, *inter alia*, promoting mixed land use in area-based developments; housing and inclusiveness; creating walkable localities; preserving and developing open spaces; promoting a variety of transport options *vis*. Transit Oriented Development (TOD), public transport and last mile para-transport connectivity; making governance citizen-friendly and cost effective; giving an identity to the city based on its main economic activity; and Applying Smart Solutions to infrastructure and services in area-based development in order to make them better.
- (b) As on 12th July, 2024, a total of ₹5,502 crore has been released to the 11 smart cities of Tamil Nadu, out of which ₹5,332 crore have been utilized. In the last four financial years, i.e. FY 2020-2021 to FY 2023-24, a total of ₹3,044 crore has been released to these smart cities. District/ City wise details of total funds released by Central Government to all 11 smart cities of TN and total utilization is at Annexure-I.
- (c) and (d): The 11 smart cities of Tamil Nadu have undertaken a total of 733 projects amounting to ₹17,984 crore out of which 706 projects amounting to ₹17,390 crore have been completed. List of projects in the smart cities of Tamil Nadu under SCM is at Annexure-II.

- (e) All 11 cities in the State of Tamil Nadu have received the full fund support as Central assistance under SCM. The Smart Cities of Tamil Nadu have undertaken comprehensive and diverse projects, including, *inter-alia*, data oriented urban management through Integrated Command and Control Centres (ICCC), projects on economic development *vis*. Redevelopment of Pondy Bazaar in Chennai, Development of public spaces like Race Course Road in Coimbatore, revitalization of seven lakes & Koval Lakefront development in Coimbatore, improving overall traffic management and promoting non-motorized transport on Jeyaraj Road in Thoothukudi.
- (f) Under SCM, diverse set of urban transformative projects focusing on improvement of overall quality of life of its citizens have been completed. Some of the key outcomes of the Mission are as under:
 - (i) **Public Safety and Security:** More than 84,000 CCTV surveillance cameras have been installed in 100 smart cities assisting in crime monitoring. 1,884 emergency call boxes, more than 3,000 public address systems, and traffic enforcement systems for red light violation, automatic number plate recognition, etc. have also been installed improving public safety.
 - (ii) **Water Supply:** More than 9,900 kms of water supply system being monitored through Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system, reducing the Non-Revenue Water in our cities.
 - (iii) **Solid Waste Management:** More than 50 cities are managing Solid Waste Management with increased usage of technology, which has improved Route Management, Efficiency of Collection and Daily Management. Around 5,200 vehicles have been RFID enabled for Automatic Vehicle Location (AVL) to digitize and improve the efficiency of solid waste management.
 - (iv) **Streetlights:** More than 52 Lakhs Solar/ LED Streetlights have been installed and over 89,000 kms of underground electricity cabling constructed.
 - (v) **Mobility:** More than 4,700 kms of smart roads constructed/ improved and 478 kms of cycle tracks developed. Further, the Intelligent Transport Management System (ITMS) has been implemented and monitored through the ICCCs improving traffic operations and air quality, enforcing traffic violations, and improving journey time.
 - (vi) **Affordable Housing and Shelter:** More than 49,000 Dwelling Units constructed, and 1,562 rooms built in community housing projects like Rain Basera, Hostel (non-educational), night shelters etc. under the Mission.
 - (vii) **Smart Solutions:** More than 9,400 number of WiFi hotspot locations created, and more than 84,000 CCTV cameras installed.
 - (viii) **Education:** More than 7,400 smart classrooms have been developed and 45 numbers of Digital Library developed.
 - (ix) **Health:** 196 e-health centers and clinics have been developed (without dedicated beds) and 151 numbers of health ATMs installed.
 - (x) **Economic Hubs:** 23 incubation centers/skill development centers developed and over 55 market redevelopment projects completed, thereby improving the employability and overall employment.
