# **REHABILITATION OF SLUM DWELLERS AND SLUM FREE CITIES**

#### 1507. SHRI SANDEEP KUMAR PATHAK

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) State/UT-wise and city-wise list of total number of slum clusters along with total households and total population living in slums of each city;
- (b) the number of slum dwelling households which have been rehabilitated in each city including the Smart Cities in the last five years;
- (c) the city-wise and year-wise data; and
- (d) the details of the steps taken by Government in the last five years to rehabilitate slum dwellers in the cities and make Indian cities slum free?

## ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS

### (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (d): Census of India conducts enumeration of population including slums on decadal basis in the country. As per Census of India 2011, a total of 6.54 crore people were living in slums across the country. State/Union Territory (UT)-wise number of towns, slum households and slum population as per Census-2011 is at Annexure.

'Land' and 'Colonization' are State subjects. Therefore, schemes to rehabilitate the population living in slums are implemented by States/UTs. City-wise data on rehabilitation of slums are not maintained by this Ministry.

However, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) supplements the efforts of States/UTs by providing Central Assistance under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana – Urban (PMAY-U) since June 25, 2015 to provide pucca house in urban areas including slums across the country through four verticals i.e., Beneficiary Led Construction (BLC), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP), In-Situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR) and Credit Linked Subsidy Scheme (CLSS). ISSR component of the scheme specifically deals with slum redevelopment using land as a resource for providing houses to eligible slum dwellers across the country including the Smart Cities.

Based on project proposals submitted by the State/UT Governments under PMAY-U, a total of 118.64 lakh houses have been sanctioned by the Ministry, out of which 114.40 lakh have been grounded and 85.43 lakh are completed/delivered to the beneficiaries in urban areas including slum dwellers as on 29.07.2024. Out of the sanctioned houses, a total of 29.37 lakh houses have been sanctioned to slum dwellers under AHP/BLC/ISSR verticals.
