**EMPANELLED HOSPITALS IN NORTH-EAST AND WEST BENGAL UNDER AB-  
PMJAY**

**1734. MS. SUSHMITA DEV:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of hospitals empanelled in the seven States of North-East and West Bengal, district-wise, under the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (ABPMJAY), both Government and private;
- (b) the total amount of funds released by Government for those States in the last five years under AB-PMJAY, year-wise; and
- (c) the number of private hospitals in these States that have pulled out of the scheme in the last five years and reasons thereof?

(a): As on 30.06.2024, the district-wise details of total number of public and private hospitals empanelled in the States of North-East and West Bengal under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) are at **Annexure-I**. AB-PMJAY is not implemented in the State of West Bengal, however, 41 hospitals, including 14 private hospitals, have been empaneled in the State to provide healthcare services to the scheme beneficiaries from other States under portability feature of the scheme.

(b): The financial year-wise details of Central share of funds released to the eight North-Eastern States in the last five years are as under:
