- (a) the funds allocated to Karnataka under Revitalizing Infrastructure and Systems in Education (RISE);
- (b) the number of educational institutes that got benefited from the fund; and
- (c) the total amount of funds utilized by the State during the last three years and the current year under RISE?

ANSWER

(DR. SUKANTA MAJUMDAR)

- (a) In order to meet the infrastructure requirement of Centrally Funded Higher Education Institutions (CFHEIs), funds are provided to CFHEIs under RISE initiatives through Higher Education Financing Agency (HEFA). There is no provision of State specific fund allocation under RISE. Institutions like IITs, NITs, IIITs, IIMs, CUs, IISERs and IISc are eligible for funding under RISE initiatives.
- (b) Four Centrally Funded institutions IIT Dharwad, NIT Surathkal, IISc Bangalore and Central University of Karnataka have been benefited from this initiative in the state of Karnataka.
- (c) An amount of Rs. 438.40 crore has been utilized by above four institutions till 30.06.2024, out of which Rs. 157.93 crore has been utilized during the last three years (F.Y. 2021-22 to 2023-24) and Rs. 36.29 crore has been utilized in current financial year 2024-25 till 30.06.2024.
