PLAN TO AUGMENT PASSENGER CAPACITY AT AIRPORTS IN THE COUNTRY

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether Government is working on a plan to augment passenger capacity at airports in the country;
- (b) if so, the number of airports that have been selected so far in the country under this scheme;
- (c) whether Ahmedabad airport in Gujarat has also been selected for augmentation of passenger capacity; and
- (d) if so, the details of the percentage increase that has been planned in the total passenger capacity at Ahmedabad airport?

(a) to (d): At present, the passenger handling capacity of Ahmedabad Airport in Gujarat is 16.8 Million Passengers Per Annum (MPPA). The upgradation of infrastructure/facilities at airports including augmentation of passenger capacity, is a continuous process, undertaken by the Airports Authority of India (AAI) or the concerned Airport Operators depending upon operational requirements, traffic, demand, commercial feasibility, availability of land etc.
