ONE STOP CENTRES IN ANDHRA PRADESH

1918. SHRI YERRAM VENKATA SUBBA REDDY:

Will the Minister of Women and Child Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of One Stop Centres in the country, district-wise and State-wise;
- (b) whether it is a fact that 300 One Stop Centres are going to be set up during the 15th Finance Commission Period;
- (c) the criteria being adopted to start above addl. OSCs;
- (d) the details of OSCs going to be set up in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (e) the details of aspirational districts in Andhra Pradesh and whether any preference given to aspirational districts in setting up of OSCs?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT
(SHRIMATI ANNPURNA DEVI)

(a): The One Stop Centre (OSC) scheme being implemented by the Government since 1st April, 2015, is now a component of sub-scheme 'Sambal' under umbrella scheme named 'Mission Shakti' for safety, security and empowerment of women. So far, a total of 816 One Stop Centres have been approved in all 36 States/UTs, out of which 786 OSCs are operational. The State/UT wise approved and functional OSCs including the State of Andhra Pradesh are annexed at **Annexure-I**.

(b): Based on the recommendations of the Third Party Evaluation conducted in 2020-21 by NITI Aayog, 300 more OSCs were envisaged to be set up during the 15th Finance Commission Period.

(c): The criteria for setting up of new OSCs in the districts includes those districts having higher rate of crime against women or having bigger geographical area, preferably the aspirational districts. Further, as the scheme is demand driven by the States and UTs, they are encouraged to establish more than one OSCs in a district depending upon these parameters.

(d): The details of district wise approved and Operational One Stop Centres (OSCs) in Andhra Pradesh are annexed at **Annexure-II**.

(e): In Andhra Pradesh, the districts of Vizianagaram, Visakhapatnam & Y.S.R. Kadapa have been declared aspirational districts by NITI Aayog. OSCs in the districts of Vizianagaram and Visakhapatnam have been functioning since 2015-16 and OSC in the district of Y.S.R. Kadapa has been functioning since 2016-17.
