(a) to (b) Recommendations of Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) on "Introduction of Calling Name Presentation (CNAP) in Telecommunication Networks" has been received on 23.02.2024, wherein TRAI has recommended that prior to the implementation of CNAP service on pan-India basis in Indian telecommunication network, a trial and assessment of implementation of CNAP service should be undertaken in one licensed service area (LSA). The necessary steps have been taken by the Government to start the trial and assessment of the implementation of CNAP Service by Telecom Service Providers.
