204. SMT. SUMITRA BALMIK:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of students who appeared for CUET 2024 subject-wise, State-wise along with the total number of subject-tests given;
- (b) whether the test was held in pen paper mode for a few subjects, if so details thereof;
- (c) the total number of participating Universities;
- (d) the total number of subject stream combinations available for students; and
- (e) the average number of subject-test given by each student?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUKANTA MAJUMDAR)

(a) to (e) The National Testing Agency (NTA) conducted CUET (UG) 2024 Examination in hybrid mode, utilising both Computer based Test (CBT) and pen and paper formats, for 13,47,819 candidates who opted for 57,95,211 combinations of subjects. As announced vide NTA Public Notice dated 20th April, 2024, examination for the subjects, i.e. Chemistry, Biology, English, General Test, Economics, Hindi, Physics, Mathematics, Geography, Physical Education, Business Studies, Accountancy, History, Political Science, and Sociology was held in pen and paper mode. Each Candidate was allowed to choose a maximum 06 Subjects including languages (Indian and Foreign) and General Test. A total of 63 subjects were offered in the CUET (UG)-2024. Average number of subject tests per candidate as per registration data is 4.28 and as per appeared data is 3.43. A total of 297 Universities are participating in the CUET ((UG)-2024. State-wise registration data of candidates is enclosed as Annexure.
