SURVEY OF BENEFICIARIES OF PMAY-G

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the survey of the remaining beneficiaries of Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) has been conducted by Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the steps taken by Government for the remaining beneficiaries of PMAY-G?

ANSWER

(a) to (c): In order to achieve the target of "Housing for All" in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1st April, 2016 to construct 2.95 crore houses by providing assistance to eligible rural households with basic amenities. Under PMAY-G out of the overall mandated target of 2.95 crore houses allocated to States/UTs, more than 2.94 crore houses have already been sanctioned to the beneficiaries and 2.64 crore houses have already been completed as on 05.08.2024. The identification of beneficiaries under PMAY-G is based on the housing deprivation parameters and exclusion criteria prescribed under Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC)-2011 and due verification by the respective Gram Sabhas and completion of an Appellate Process. These parameters/criteria are applied on both SECC 2011 & Awaas+ 2018 survey data to identify eligible of beneficiary under PMAY-G.

The Government conducted Awaas+ survey during January 2018 to March 2019 to identify those beneficiaries which claimed to have been left out from the SECC 2011 survey. During Awaas+ survey, a total of 3.90 crore potentially eligible households were registered by the States/UTs and after remanding/verification by Gram Sabhas, a total of 2.79 crore were found potentially eligible by the States/UTs. Of the overall mandate of 2.95 crore households, 2.04 crore beneficiary households have been identified from SECC 2011 survey database and to fill the gap of 91 lakh households (2.95-2.04), Awaas+ survey database was utilized after following due verification process by Gram Sabhas and Appellate Process thereafter.

In addition, Government of India announced 2 Crore more houses to be constructed in the next five years till FY 2028-29 under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana Gramin (PMAY-G) to meet the arising needs of the rural households.
