(a) to (c) The Government of India has enacted the Mediation Act, 2023 which seeks to promote and facilitate mediation, especially institutional mediation for resolution of disputes. The Act enables granting of recognition to mediation institutes and mediation service providers, specifying the criteria for recognition of mediation institutes and mediation service providers and streamlining the mediation process in the country. There is no proposal being considered by the Government of India regarding establishment of mediation centres at the Panchayat level.
