**GATI SHAKTI NATIONAL MASTER PLAN**

**271. SHRI HARSH MAHAJAN:**  
**DR. BHIM SINGH:**

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the approved schemes for strengthening connectivity through various modes of transport under the Prime Minister's Gati Shakti National Master Plan in Himachal Pradesh and Bihar;
- (b) the total amount allocated and utilised under the above schemes, scheme-wise; and
- (c) the current status of connectivity in various states and Union Territories of the country, particularly in Himachal Pradesh and Bihar?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

(a) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan is essentially a digital platform for integrated planning and coordinated implementation of infrastructure connectivity projects. All the NHs development projects costing more than Rs. 500 crore of this Ministry are planned in line with Pradhan Mantri (PM) Gati Shakti - National Master Plan (NMP) principles. Details of such NHs development projects approved in last 2 Financial Years in the States of Himachal Pradesh and Bihar are as under:-

| S.No. | State            | No. | Length (Km) | Cost (in Rs. Crore) |

| 1     | Himachal Pradesh | 8   | 169         | 8957                |
