### INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FROM AMRITSAR AIRPORT

- (a) whether Government is aware that international flights have been discontinued from Amritsar International Airport leading to inconvenience to the people of Punjab;
- (b) if so, whether there is any proposal to revive international flights operation from Amritsar Airport; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

## **ANSWER**

- (a) International flights are operating from Amritsar International Airport. Currently, Amritsar has direct international operations to/from Birmingham, Doha, Dubai, Kuala Lumpur, London Gatwick, Milan, Rome, Sharjah, Singapore and Verona. Both Indian carriers and foreign carriers are operating from Amritsar airport.
