**INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS FROM AMRITSAR AIRPORT**

Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-

(a) whether Government is aware that international flights have been discontinued from Amritsar International Airport leading to inconvenience to the people of Punjab;

(b) if so, whether there is any proposal to revive international flights operation from Amritsar Airport; and

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) International flights are operating from Amritsar International Airport. Currently, Amritsar has direct international operations to/from Birmingham, Doha, Dubai, Kuala Lumpur, London Gatwick, Milan, Rome, Sharjah, Singapore and Verona. Both Indian carriers and foreign carriers are operating from Amritsar airport.

(b) and (c) do not arise, in view of the (a) above.
