**STARTING OF FLIGHT OPERATIONS FROM JABALPUR AIRPORT**

**35. SMT SUMITRA BALMIK**

**Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:-**

- (a) the details of the new flights planned to be operated from Jabalpur Airport in the coming days;**
- (b) the occupancy percentage of flights operating from Jabalpur and corresponding details since last two years; and**
- (c) the details of the facilities to be expanded in the new terminal, capacity of the terminal and whether there is any proposal on facilitating night landing facility therein?**

**ANSWER**

**Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (Shri Murlidhar Mohol)**

**(a): The airlines plan their flight schedule on a specific route keeping in view the market demand, commercial viability and their policy. The details of operations to / from Jabalpur Airport as per the Summer Schedule 2024, as approved by Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGCA), are at Annexure I. The current air connectivity of Jabalpur Airport is at Annexure II.**

**(b): The details of the aircraft movement and the passengers handled at the Jabalpur Airport for the last two years are at Annexure III.**

**(c): The development and expansion of an airport is an ongoing process. The total Terminal Area at the airport is 10700 Sqm and the peak hour passenger capacity being increased from 800 to 1050. The number of security check machines may also be increased from 3 to 6. Night Landing facilities at Jabalpur Airport are already available.**
