STATUS OF KVKs IN THE COUNTRY

497. SHRI DHANANJAY BHIMRAO MAHADIK:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objective of setting up Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) alongwith the number of KVKs that are currently in operation, State-wise including Maharashtra;
- (b) whether Government proposes to set up more KVKs;
- (c) if so, the details of the locations identified to set up such KVKs in the State of Maharashtra; and
- (d) whether Government has taken steps to upgrade the infrastructure of KVKs across the country for better services to the farmers and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE & FARMERS WELFARE

(a): The Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs) have mandate of technology assessment and demonstration for its application and capacity development. The activities of KVKs include on-farm testing to identify the location specificity of technology under various farming systems; frontline demonstration to establish the production potential of improved agricultural technologies on the farmers' fields; capacity development of farmers for knowledge and skill up gradation; and production of quality seeds, planting materials and other technology inputs for availability to the farmers. In order to develop awareness of modern agricultural technology among the farmers, a large number of extension activities are taken up by the KVKs.

A total of 731 KVKs are operational across the Country. The State/UT-wise list of KVKs is at **Annexure-I**.

(b)&(c): National Commission on Agriculture (1976) in its report on "Research, Education and Extension", recommended to have one KVK in each district. Opening of New KVKs in newly created districts is a continuous process as per the prescribed procedure and guidelines.

(d): Government makes continuous efforts to upgrade the infrastructure of KVKs across the Country for better services to the farmers. During last year Government made Rs.7730.76 lakh budget provision for upgrading the infrastructure.

Infrastructure includes Administrative Building, Farmers Hostel, Staff Quarters, Demonstration Unit, Farm Development Works. Upgradation of infrastructure at the KVKs is a continuous process.
