PROMOTON OF ORGANIC FARMING

510. DR. M. THAMBIDURAI:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE & FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is promoting organic farming in the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof including the details of the total area covered under organic farming during the last three years, year-wise, State-wise;

(c) the details of the funds earmarked and spent for promoting organic farming year-wise, State-wise; and

(d) further steps likely to be taken to promote organic farming in the country?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

(SHRI SHIVRAJ SINGH CHOUHAN)

(a) & (b): Government has been promoting organic farming on priority in the country since 2015-16 through the schemes of Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY) in all the States other-than North Eastern States and Mission Organic Value Chain Development for North Eastern Region (MOVCDNER). Both the schemes stress on end-to-end support to farmers engaged in organic farming i.e. from production to processing, certification and marketing and post-harvest management Training and Capacity Building are integral part of the scheme.

Under PKVY scheme, a total assistance of Rs. 31,500 per ha for a period of three years is provided for promotion of organic farming to cover different components like Training & Capacity Building, Data Management, PGS Certification, value addition, marketing and publicity. Out of this, the assistance of Rs. 15,000 per ha for a period of three years is provided to farmers through DBT for on- farm /off –farm organic inputs.

Whereas under MOVCDNER, a total assistance of Rs. 46,500/ha for 3 years is provided for creation of FPO, support to farmers for organic inputs, quality seeds/ planting material and training, hand holding and certification. Out of this, assistance @ Rs. 32500/ ha for 3 years is provided to farmers for off -farm /on –farm organic inputs under the scheme including Rs. 15,000 as DBT to the farmers and Rs. 17,500 for the planting material to be given to the farmers by State Lead Agency (SLA) in kind.

The total cumulative area (Govt. + State/Private initiatives) covered under organic farming in the country is 63.27 lakh ha area [NPOP - 44.75 lakh ha (MOVCDNER 1.73 lakh ha + State/Private initiatives - 43.02) + PGS - 18.52 lakh ha (PKVY -14.99 lakh ha + NRLM- 1.80 lakh ha + State/Private initiatives - 1.73 lakh ha)]

Year –wise and State wise details of total cumulative area covered under organic farming (under NPOP – 44.75 lakh ha (MOVCDNER 1.73 lakh ha + State/Private initiatives – 43.02) & (PKVY -14.99 lakh ha) during the last three years is given at **Annexure-I & II**.

(c): The State wise details of fund allocated and spent/released during the last three years for promoting organic farming (under PKVY & MOVCDNER) is given at **Annexure-III.**

(d): Organic farming is a priority for the Government and it is envisaged to bring additional 6.00 lakh ha area under PKVY scheme till 2025-26 and 5.86 lakh ha area has already been sanctioned under PKVY. Similarly under MOVCDNER 50,000 ha is targeted to be brought under organic farming till 2025-26 and 50,000 ha area has already been sanctioned under MOVCDNER.

Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation (DDWS) is implementing Phase – II of Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM) (Grameen) in a mission mode from 2020-21 to 2024-25. Galvanizing Organic Bio- Resources-Dhan (GOBARdhan), launched in 2018 under SBM (G), is now an integral component of bio degradable waste management under SBM (G) Phase-II for ensuring cleanliness in villages by converting organic and biodegradable waste including cattle dung, crop residue, market waste etc. into bio-gas and bio-slurry. Financial assistance of upto Rs. 50 lakh per Districts is available for the entire programme period.

DDWS is coordinating the implementation of GOBARdhan initiatives of GoI and has developed a unified registration portal for GOBARdhan. As per Department of Fertilizer's Office Memorandum dated 18.07.2023 on policy on promotion of organic fertilizers, only those Compressed Bio Gas (CBG)/ Biogas plants registered on Unified Registration Portal for GOBARdhan shall be eligible for the Market Development assistance @ Rs 1500/MT.

Government is promoting use of organic fertilizers including storage and distribution of organic fertilizers, Government has announced Market Development Assistance (MDA) @ Rs 1,500/MT for Fermented Organic Manure (FOM), Liquid Organic Manure (LOM) and Phosphate Rich Organic Manure (PROM).
