SETTING UP OF ECO-PARKS

51. DR. ANIL SUKHDEORAO BONDE:

Will the Minister of Coal be pleased to state:

- (a) total number of eco-parks set up in the country including Maharashtra during last five years, year-wise;
- (b) details of initial amount of funds allocated and the extra funds needed to complete each ecopark project;
- (c) whether Government plans to set up new eco-parks to promote eco-tourism in mining areas;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the estimated funds required for the same; and
- (e) whether the revenues earned from eco-parks and mining tourism is used to develop the mining areas for the living conditions of the locals and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF COAL AND MINES (SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a) & (b): Coal/Lignite Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) have established 16 Eco-Parks/Mine Tourism Sites during the last 5 years including one Eco-Park/Mine Tourism Site in the State of Maharashtra. The State-wise and year-wise details of total number of Eco-Parks/Mine Tourism Sites developed by Coal/Lignite PSUs during last five years and details of initial amount of funds allocated by Coal/Lignite PSUs and the extra funds needed to complete each eco-park project are given at Annexure I.
- (c) & (d): The details of new Eco-Parks/Mine Tourism Sites of to be developed by Coal/Lignite PSUs, along with estimated funds, are given at Annexure II.
- (e): Eco-parks/Mine Tourism Sites are developed by Coal/Lignite PSUs as a part of reclamation/plantation, to boost local tourism and promote conservation in mining areas and not for revenue earning. However, Kenapara Eco-park of South Eastern Coalfields Limited (SECL), Chhattisgarh is run and maintained by local Self-Help Groups to promote mine-tourism. The Self-Help Groups are also earning revenues from floating restaurant, pisciculture and boating facilities of the eco-parks for their livelihood.
