**PROJECTS UNDER PMGSY ESPECIALLY IN KARNATAKA**

620 SHRI IRANNA KADADI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total area covered under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) till June 2024 along with its present status, State-wise;
- (b) the special steps taken by Government for providing road connectivity in the rural areas of the country;
- (c) the details of projects implemented under the said Yojana, especially in Karnataka;
- (d) the details of the proposed, ongoing and completed PMGSY projects during the said period in Karnataka, district-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken by Government to make improvements in PMGSY?

**ANSWER**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT

(a): The State-wise present status of road length sanctioned and constructed under various interventions/verticals of the PMGSY across the country including Karnataka State till June, 2024 is given at **Annexure-I**. The State-wise, vertical-wise details may be accessed on PMGSY website at [www.omms.nic.in](http://www.omms.nic.in) > **Progress Monitoring**> **State Abstract Report**.

(b): Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has taken up different phases of PMGSY for road connectivity in the rural areas. The objectives of different phases are:

Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) was launched in the year 2000 to provide all-weather road connectivity to unconnected habitations of population size 500+ in plain areas and 250+ in North-eastern States, Hills and other special areas.

PMGSY-II was started in 2013 with a target to upgrade 50,000 Km of the existing rural road network to improve its overall efficiency as a provider of transportation services for people, goods and services. Subsequently, Road Connectivity Project for Left Wing Extremism Areas (RCPLWEA) was launched in 2016 with an aim to improve the road connectivity in 44 districts in 9 States.

PMGSY-III was launched in 2019 for consolidation of 1,25,000 Km Through Routes and Major Rural Links connecting habitations, inter-alia, to Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs), Higher Secondary Schools and Hospitals. All projects under PMGSY-I & II were targeted for completion by March, 2024. The implementation period of PMGSY-III and RCPLWEA are upto March, 2025.

(c) & (d) A total of 24,208 Km road length has been sanctioned in Karnataka under various ongoing interventions/verticals of PMGSY, out of which 23,863 Km road length has already been completed and 211 Km road length are at various stages of execution. The district wise details of road length sanctioned, completed in the State of Karnataka under PMGSY are given at **Annexure-II**.

(e): The Government has implemented several measures to enhance the effectiveness and reach of PMGSY. These steps include:

- i. Geographic Information System (GIS) and Online Management, Monitoring, and Accounting System (OMMAS) used for better planning and monitoring of road projects and real-time tracking of project progress respectively
- ii. National Quality Monitors (NQMs) and State Quality Monitors (SQMs) based quality monitoring mechanism set up to ensure adherence to standards.
- iii. Adoption of new construction technologies and materials to improve road durability and reduce maintenance costs
- iv. Use of mobile applications for on-site data collection and monitoring by field engineers
- v. Workshops and seminars have been organized in order to disseminate best practices and new technologies
- vi. Ensuring timely release of funds to States for uninterrupted progress of road construction
- vii. Prioritizing connectivity to unconnected habitations, especially in remote and hilly areas.
- viii. Special focus on Left Wing Extremism (LWE) affected districts to promote inclusive development.
- ix. Establishing grievance redressal mechanisms to address concerns and feedback from the public through GeoSadak.
- x. Introduction of Electronic Maintenance of Rural Roads (eMARG) as a measure of further enhancing the focus on maintenance of roads during the defect liability period (DLP) and also streamlining the delivery of routine maintenance of PMGSY roads
