Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of tap connections provided in Madhya Pradesh under the Har Ghar Nal Se Jal Yojana till date; and
- (b) the status of Parliamentary constituencies situated in Madhya Pradesh under the said scheme and the details of all the areas?

ANSWER

(a) and (b) Since August 2019, Government of India is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) in partnership with States to make provision of tap water supply to every rural household of the country, including those in Madhya Pradesh.

As reported by the State of Madhya Pradesh, at the time of launch of Jal Jeevan Mission in the State on 15th August 2019, approximately 13.53 lakh rural households had tap water connections. Since then, 57.89 lakhs additional rural households have been provided with tap water connections. Thus, as on 25.07.2024, the provision of tap water supply is made available to around 71.41 lakhs (63.87%) rural households in Madhya Pradesh.

The parliamentary constituency-wise details under JJM are not maintained at the Government of India level. However, the number of tap water connections provided to rural households under JJM in Madhya Pradesh, district- wise is **annexed**.
