ROLE OF ONGC IN EXPLORATION OF CRUDE OIL RESERVES

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:-

- (a) whether the Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Limited (ONGC) has explored crude oil reserves during the last three years and the current year;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the estimated quantum of various varieties of oil available in these reserves ;
- (c) the number of oil reserves from where oil is being extracted by ONGC along with the quantum of oil available in these reserves; and
- (d) the quantum of oil being produced by ONGC from these reserves annually and the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) As a part of exploration activity during the last three years and the current year, ONGC has acquired 3,743.71 Line Kilometre (LKM) of two dimensional (2D) and 30,417.91 Square Kilometre (SKM) of three dimensional (3D) seismic data. It has drilled 276 exploratory wells, which established around 172.54 Million Metric Tonne (MMT) of 2P (Proven and Probable) Oil Initially In-Place (OIIP) reserves with 46.58 MMT estimated ultimate recovery (EUR).

(c) As on 01.04.2024, ONGC has oil reserves in 9 sedimentary basins which have a total 2P (Proven and Probable) reserves of 320.89 MMT.

(d) Details of production of crude oil (including condensate) by ONGC from their oil reserves during the last three years and the current year (up to June 2024) are as under:-
