- (b) the notable achievement of the Yojana since its inception;
- (c) the details of projects approved and funded to the organization under Ayurswasthya Yojana during the year 2022-23, State/UT-wise;
- (d) whether some of the Research Councils under the Ministry are running mobile health care programme across the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) whether under the Ayush & Public Health component of the Scheme, there is provision for funding to the eligible organization and the step taken to promote AYUSH interventions in sports medicine?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH
(SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) & (b) The Ministry of Ayush is implementing a Central Sector Scheme namely AYURSWASTHYA Yojana, since FY 2021-22. The Scheme has 02 components viz. (i) AYUSH and Public Health (ii) Centre of Excellence (CoE). The detailed guideline of the scheme is available on the Ministry's website (www.ayush.gov.in). The notable achievement under Yojana since inception is placed at **Annexure I**.

(c) Under the Scheme, the funds are not approved/allocated State/UT-wise. Further, details of the projects approved and funded under the scheme during the year 2022-23 is placed at **Annexure II**.

(d) The Research Councils under this Ministry are running mobile health care programme across the country. Details are placed at Annexure **III**.

(e) Under the Ayush & Public Health component of the Scheme, there is provision for funding upto Rs.1.50 crore to the eligible organizations. Detailed guideline to promote use of Ayush interventions in sports medicine for promoting health and fitness of sport persons is available on the Ministry's website (www.ayush.gov.in).
