National Ayush Mission in Andhra Pradesh

816 Shri V. Vijayasai Reddy:

Will the Minister of *Ayush* be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of health and wellness centres sanctioned in Andhra Pradesh under the National Ayush Mission till date;
- (b) whether the 110 health and wellness centres are functionally active in Andhra Pradesh;
- (c) whether AYUSH hospitals have been set up in Andhra Pradesh;
- (e) whether infrastructural upgrades have been conducted in AYUSH dispensaries in Andhra Pradesh; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH

(a) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), as per the proposals received from the State Government of Andhra Pradesh through their State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs), Ministry of Ayush has approved 126 Ayush Dispensaries to be upgraded as Ayush Health and Wellness Centres [now renamed as Ayushman Arogya Mandir (Ayush)].

(b) As reported by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, all 126 Ayushman Arogya Mandir (Ayush) are functional.

(c) Public Health being a State Subject, setting up of Ayush Hospitals comes under the purview of respective State/UT Governments. As per the proposals received from State Government of Andhra Pradesh through SAAPs, Ministry of Ayush has approved for the establishment of 02 Integrated Ayush Hospitals at Kakinada and Vishakhapatnam Districts.

(e) & (f) Under NAM, as per the proposals received from State Government of Andhra Pradesh through SAAPs, Ministry of Ayush has supported 23 Ayush dispensaries for infrastructural upgradation.
