Tap connection under Jal Jeevan Mission in Chhattisgarh

87# SMT. PHULO DEVI NETAM:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of houses targeted to be provided with tap connections under the Jal Jeevan Mission in the State of Chhattisgarh;
- (b) the number of houses provided with tap connections in compliance with the said target;
- (c) the details of houses devoid of tap connections including Bastar and Kanker districts; and
- (d) by when the said target is likely to be achieved?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) Government of India in partnership with State/UTs is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal to make provision of potable water to every rural household of the country, through functional household tap water connection i.e. at a service level of 55 litre per capita per day (lpcd), of prescribed quality (BIS:10500), on regular and long-term basis.

As reported by the Government of Chhattisgarh on Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of the Department as on 16.07.2024, 50,05,219 households are targeted for providing tap connections in the State of Chhattisgarh and 39,23,716 households are provided with tap connections till date.

10,81,503 households in all including in Baster and Kanker districts are still to be provided tap connections in State of Chhattisgarh as per data available on JJM IMIS Dashboard as on 16.07.2024 for which works are ongoing. The state government expects to complete the works by March 2026.
