**INADEQUATE MEDICAL FACILITIES IN AIIMS (HP)**

**915. Dr. SIKANDER KUMAR :**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether medical facilities in All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Bilaspur is inadequate to meet the requirements of the people in Himachal Pradesh;
- (b) the total amount allotted to AIIMS, Bilaspur (HP) for the last three years for its development;
- (c) the improvements made to provide medicines and other facilities to the patients in the last two years and current year; and
- (d) whether Government has taken any steps to improve the facilities to the patients?

(a) to (d): All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Bilaspur has been established under Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) with 750 bedded hospital to cater the needs of the patients of the state and nearby areas. The Institute has 35 functional Departments including 13 Super Speciality Departments, 19 Broad Speciality Departments and 3 Pre-Clinical Departments. The patient care services provided by the Institute include OPD, IPD, Emergency, Laboratory services, Radio Diagnosis, Radio therapy, Speciality Clinics, Neo Natal ICU, Paediatric ICU, Blood Bank, Pharmacy, etc. The total grant in aid released to AIIMS, Bilaspur under PMSSY in the last three years is as under:

Two Amrit Pharmacy and one Jan Aushadhi centre is functional in the institute. In addition, the institute has its own internal stock of essential medicines and emergency drugs for the patients. Separate registration counters for patients with special needs, pregnant women, elderly and ex-servicemen, Feeding Kiosks, Canteen facilities, Teleconsultation, Patient Education Programmes, Ambulance services etc. are provided by the Institute. HIMCARE and AYUSHMAN BHARAT schemes are implemented in AIIMS Bilaspur.
