- (a) the details of School of Planning and Architecture (SPAs) in India and the number of students studying in SPAs, State-wise;
- (b) whether Government intends to open more SPAs in future, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of Government or Private Schools/Colleges or any premier institutions for studying Planning and Architecture in India, State-wise?

(a) to (c) At present, there are 3 centrally funded Schools of Planning and Architecture (SPAs) situated in Delhi, Bhopal (Madhya Pradesh) & Vijayawada (Andhra Pradesh) established under SPA Act, 2014 as Institutions of National Importance. The number of students studying in centrally funded SPAs are given below:

IITs, NITs, CUs, SPAs are autonomous bodies imparting technical education as per mandate of their respective Acts. Besides SPAs, Departments of Architecture and Planning also exist in many IITs/NITs/Universities. Opening of new institutions and strengthening of institutions is a continuous exercise which is done on the basis of an assessment and availability of seats, demand for specific course and consultation with industries.
