- (b) the reasons for closing of Schools in the country;
- (c) the Enrollment rate of students in the country during the last five years, State-wise; and
- (d) the rate of Enrollment of students in the country in 2024, State-wise?

(a) and (b): The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSEL), Ministry of Education has developed the Unified District Information System for Education Plus (UDISE+) system to record data on indicators of school education provided by all the States and Union Territories. The total number of government (including Union Government-owned) and private schools State-wise as per UDISE+ for the years 2017-18 to 2021-22 are at annexure I: The data upto 2021-22 has been released only.

Education being in the concurrent list of the Constitution of India and majority of the schools are under the domain of respective State and UT Governments. The opening and closing of schools are within the purview of respective State Governments and UT Administrations.

(c) and (d): The state-wise gross enrolment rate of students as per UDISE+ at the level of school education for the years 2017-18 to 2021-22 is at annexure II respectively. The data upto 2021-22 has been released only.
