TAP WATER CONNECTIONS IN KARNATAKA

99. DR. DHARMASTHALA VEERENDRA HEGGADE:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to State:

- (a) the number of villages in Karnataka which have been provided with tap water connection as on 31st March, 2024, district-wise;
- (b) the number of villages of Karnataka particularly of Dakshina Kannada and Udupi districts in which all the households have been benefitted with Har Ghar Nal connection under the Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM);
- (c) the State/ UT-wise and year-wise details of tap connections provided as on 31st March, 2024;
- (d) the year-wise and State/ UT-wise details of JJM central fund allocated and fund drawn by the States/ UTs during last five years; and
- (e) the key highlights of Study conducted by IIM-B titled "Assessment of Employment Potential of Jal Jeevan Mission"?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) As reported by the State Government of Karnataka, 24,856 villages have been provided with tap water connection as on 16.07.2024. Out of these 24,856 villages, 9,382 villages are fully covered with tap water connection i.e. 100% households are getting tap water connection and remaining 15,474 villages are partially covered and works for providing 100% tap water connection are at various stages.

The district-wise details of villages along with no. of households with tap water connection and no. of villages with 100% FHTC in Karnataka, as on 16.07.2024 is at **Annexure-I**. Further, 125 villages in Dakshina Kannada and 69 villages in Udupi districts have 100% tap connections.

(d) The State/ UT-wise and year-wise details of funds allocated, released and utilized under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) during the last five years are at **Annexure-II**.

(e) The key highlights of Study conducted by IIM-B titled "Assessment of Employment Potential of Jal Jeevan Mission" are as under:

- i.) The study assesses employment generation potentials of Jal Jeevan Mission.
- ii.) JJM generated employment at its scheme constructions phase as well as in the operations phase.
- iii.) At construction phase employment is one-time activity whereas in the operations phase employment generated is long term.
- iv.) The study utilizes both secondary data and scheme-level primary data from major States of India
- v.) The study uses input-output model and ratio method to assess the overall, as well as the direct and indirect employment potentials. While direct employment refers to the people directly employed in creating the infrastructure and its operations, indirect employment refers to the employment generated while manufacturing all the raw, intermediate and finished materials required for JJM scheme.
- vi.) The study results suggest that JJM has the potential to generate an average of 59.9 lakh person-year of direct and 2.22 crore person-year of indirect employment during the construction phase, and 11.1 lakh person-year of additional direct employment annually during the operation and maintenance phase at the country level.
- vii.) The study highlights the spillover effects of public investments in the form of employment generation and indicates that the impact of JJM is likely to be substantial.
