# UPGRADATION OF AIRPORTS UNDER RCS IN CHHATTISGARH

- (a) the details of the number of airstrips being upgraded, developed by the Chhattisgarh State Government under the Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS);
- (b) the total amount provisioned under the said scheme;
