(a) to (c) Under National Health Mission (NHM), Government provides technical and financial support to the States/UTs including Punjab for improvement in health infrastructure, availability of adequate human resources to health facilities, to improve availability and accessibility to quality health care especially for the underserved and marginalized groups.

For the FY 2024-25 under NHM Central share allocation for the State of Punjab is Rs. 654.90 crore, out of which Rs. 313.41 crore has been released.

State/UT wise details of the amounts approved for the Component of 'National Programme – Non Communicable Diseases (NP-NCD)' under NHM for the period FY 2021-24 including Punjab is given at Annexure.
