Implementation of PMGSY in Nagaland

- (a) the total number of villages and habitations in Nagaland that have been connected under the Pradhan MantriGraminSadakYojana (PMGSY) in the last three years; and
- (b) the details of total funds that have been allocated to Nagaland under PMGSY in the last three years?

(a) & (b): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) AND (B) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 197 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 13.12.2024

(a): Under Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY)-I, the unit of programme is 'habitation'. Since Financial Year 2021-22, 09 eligible habitations have been provided all-weather road connectivity under PMGSY in the State of Nagaland.

(b): During last three years i.e. from Financial Year 2021-22 to 2023-24, Central funds of ₹. 489.74 Crore have been released to Nagaland State under all verticals of PMGSY. The State Government has also released the corresponding State share of ₹.54.41 Crore during this period.

Further, unspent PMGSY funds of ₹74.81 Crore were available with the State as on 1^{st} April, 2024. The State is to achieve required financial utilization to be eligible for the next grant.
