- (a) the total number of villages and habitations in Nagaland that have been connected under the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) in the last three years; and
- (b) the details of total funds that have been allocated to Nagaland under PMGSY in the last three years?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) AND (B) OF RAJYA SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO. 197 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 13.12.2024**

(a): Under Pradhan Mantri Gram SadakYojana (PMGSY)-I, the unit of programme is 'habitation'. Since Financial Year 2021-22, 09 eligible habitations have been provided all-weather road connectivity under PMGSY in the State of Nagaland.

(b): During last three years i.e. from Financial Year 2021-22 to 2023-24, Central funds of ₹. 489.74 Crore have been released to Nagaland State under all verticals of PMGSY. The State Government has also released the corresponding State share of ₹.54.41 Crore during this period.

Further, unspent PMGSY funds of ₹74.81 Crore were available with the State as on 1st April, 2024. The State is to achieve required financial utilization to be eligible for the next grant.
