Will the Minister of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is planning to develop a web portal where Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) can access the details of the schemes related to the sector being run by different Ministries;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the role of MSMEs sector in job creation and promotion of export?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (c) OF THE RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. *63 FOR ANSWER ON 02.12.2024

(a) and (b): Ministry of MSME operates a web portal (My MSME link - www.my.msme.gov.in) where detailed information about Government schemes and services pertaining to MSME sector is provided. It contains information about programmes and offerings of Ministry of MSME and related Central Ministries. List of government schemes related to MSMEs accessible through web portal is given at Annexure. Further, the Ministry has developed the Udyam Portal for registration of MSME units. It has integration with Goods and Services Tax Network (GSTN), Trade Receivables electronic Discounting System (TReDS) platforms, Central Board for Direct Taxes (CBDT) database, Government e-Marketplace (GeM), National Career Service (NCS) portal and validation from Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) systems. In addition, the Champions portal, operated by Ministry of MSME, provides information and grievance redressal, handholding and guidance through physical as well as digital means in 11 regional languages. The Ministry is constantly working to upgrade the existing portals and mechanisms through convergence and integration with schemes of other Ministries.

(c): MSME play a pivotal role in employment generation across sectors. MSME foster entrepreneurship and generate large employment opportunities at comparatively lower capital cost. MSME are also major contributor to the socioeconomic development of the country. Subsequent to the adoption of the new definition of MSME on 01.07.2020, Udyam Registration Portal and Udyam Assist Platform were launched for MSME. As on date, more than 5.53 crore MSME have been digitally registered with a self-declared employment over 23.30 crore persons.

MSME have a key role in promotion of exports through global supply chain and direct business-to-consumer and business-to-business arrangements. Presently more than 45% of total exports are provided by MSME. Government has a dedicated support system for export promotion in MSME Sector by establishing 65 Export Facilitation Centres (EFCs) in its field offices. The functions of Export Facilitation Centres (EFCs) are information dissemination, documentation and procedures, market access, finance, technology, training and workshops and other necessary support. Further, Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has also launched a new Trade Connect platform (www.trade.gov.in) with information on various aspects related to international trade to help new and existing exporters, including MSME to help them venture into international trade.
