(a) The details of allocation and utilization of funds under Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram (JSSK), State/UT-wise including Odisha is placed at Annexure-I

(b) The total number of beneficiaries under the scheme, State/UT wise is placed at Annexure-II

(c) & (d) The Government assesses the implementation of JSSK under National Health Mission (NHM) by undertaking periodic Regional/State level review meetings, field visits in various States/Union Territories (UTs) and Common Review Missions (CRMs).

Further, Government of India has taken following steps for effective implementation and strengthening of JSSK scheme;

- Communications through multiple channels with State Governments including letters, videoconferencing, etc.
- Popularizing the Scheme through Information Education & Communication (IEC) & Behaviour Change Communication (BCC) strategies including mass media
- Field level workers like ANMs, ASHAs and CHOs are promoting this programme at the ground level through interpersonal communication
- A system of regular supportive supervisory visits to the states and districts to monitor the implementation of JSSK has also been put in place.
