SHORTAGE OF DAP FOR RABI SEASON

Will the Minister of CHEMICALS AND FERTILIZERS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware that farmers across the agrarian States in North India, particularly Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh are facing acute Di-Ammonium Phosphate (DAP) shortage during the current Rabi season;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and reasons therefor;
- (c) the steps Government would take to ensure availability of DAP in the said States during Rabi seasons; and
- (d) by when DAP fertilizer would be available to farmers in these States and particularly in Uttar Pradesh?

(a) to (d): The information regarding requirement, availability, sales and closing stock of DAP in the agrarian States of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Punjab, Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh during the ongoing Rabi 2024-25 season is given as per the table below:

In case of Uttar Pradesh, Punjab and Madhya Pradesh the availability is less than the pro-rata requirement but the sales are less than the pro-rata requirement and these States are having closing stocks as indicated above. However, the distribution of fertilizers within the State is being done by the respective State to meet the requirement at the field level.
