**Repair work under Samagra Shiksha Scheme**

1000. **Smt. Mausam B Noor:**

Will the Minister of ***Education*** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Samagra Shiksha Scheme supports expenditure on major repairs in schools for better functionality;
- (b) if so, the details of expenditure shared by Government under Samagra Shiksha Scheme in schools of West Bengal in the current year;
- (c) the number of schools in which repair work was carried out and infrastructure facilities augmented in West Bengal; and
- (d) whether Government has also set any target to construct toilets in schools under Swachh Bharat Vidyalaya campaign and if so, the number of toilets constructed?

**ANSWER**

(a) & (b). Yes. An allocation of **Rs. 47.19 crore** has been approved by Project Approval Board (PAB) in respect of West Bengal for Major Repairs under Samagra Shiksha Scheme in schools during Current Financial Year (2024-25).

(c). The number of schools approved for carrying out repair work and augmenting infrastructure facilities (including Major Repair) in West Bengal under Samagra Shiksha Scheme from 2018-19 to 2024-25 (till June 2024) is 22249.

(d). Under Swachh Bharat Swachh Vidyalaya campaign 4.17 lakh toilets in 2.61 lakh Government schools were targeted for construction and all targeted toilets were constructed.
