Increase in Financial allocation towards education to Tamil Nadu

1013 Shri R. Girirajan:

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has any pending fund to be paid to Government of Tamil Nadu under various Central Schemes and Central-State schemes under education, if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the effective measures taken by Government to increase financial allocation for Government of Tamil Nadu based on its performances in GER, School infrastructure?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

- (a): There are no pending funds up to FY 2023-24 under the schemes of Samagra Shiksha, PM-POSHAN and ULLAS to be paid to the Government of Tamil Nadu. Additionally, the Government of Tamil Nadu has not onboarded the PM-SHRI scheme. Under the National Meanscum-Merit Scholarship Scheme (NMMSS), funds are not allocated to the State Government; instead, the scholarship amount is directly transferred to the beneficiaries' bank accounts through the Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode.
- (b): Financial allocation under Samagra Shiksha Scheme is based on the Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B) prepared by the States and UTs based on their requirements and priorities and guidelines issued by the Ministry of Education.
