Funds and Basic amenities to school in Andhra Pradesh

1014. SHRI YERRAM VENKATA SUBBA REDDY:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds sanctioned and utilized on major, medium and minor repairs in schools under Samagra Siksha Abhiyan (SSA) in Andhra Pradesh during last three years and current year, year-wise and district-wise;
- (b) the number of toilets for boys and girls, ramps for disabled, drinking water connections sanctioned and completed in schools during the above period, districtwise;
- (c) whether it is a fact that cumulative approval for girls' toilets under SSA in Andhra Pradesh was 21,700, but only 21,000 toilets completed;
- (d) by when remaining toilets are likely to be completed; and
- (e) the percentage of toilets functional out of 21,700, so constructed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SHRI JAYANT CHAUDHARY)

(a): As per information received from the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, the total sanctioned budget for major and minor repairs in schools in Andhra Pradesh under Samagra Shiksha during the last three years from 2021-22 to 2023-24 was ₹39.80 crores out of which ₹29.42 crores have been utilized. For the current year 2024-25, the Ministry of Education has approved a budget allocation of ₹16.92 crores for major and minor repairs out of which ₹4.23 crores have been utilized so far. District-wise details are given in Annexure-I.

- (b): As informed by the State Government of Andhra Pradesh, between 2021-22 and 2023-24, a total of 743 boys' toilets, 669 girls' toilets, and drinking water facilities in 383 schools were sanctioned. So far, 513 boys' toilets, 402 girls' toilets, and all 383 drinking water facilities have been completed. No ramps were sanctioned during the period. District-wise number of boys' toilets, girls' toilets and drinking water facilities are given at Annexure-II.
- (c) to (e): Since the inception of the Samagra Shiksha Scheme, a total of 21,722 girls' toilets have been sanctioned in Andhra Pradesh, out of which 21,453 have been completed, achieving a functional rate of 98.76%. The progress in this regard is regularly monitored through furnishing of data on PRABANDH Portal and periodic reviews with the State Government.
