100 DAYS LEAVE IN A YEAR TO PARAMILITARY/CAPF

Will the Minister of Home Affairs be pleased to state:

- (a) whether, Government has announced that at least 100 days leave will be granted in a year to Paramilitary/CAPF personnel to stay with their family;
- (b) whether there is any proposal for fresh survey in CISF for 60 days instead of 30 days Annual Leave;
- (c) if so, the number of personnel who have availed 100 days leave, Forcewise as there are large numbers of suicide/fratricide cases in Paramilitary/CAPF?

## **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a): The government has given due importance to overall well-being of personnel of Central Armed Police Forces. To this end, the Ministry has made constant efforts so that CAPF personnel spend 100 days in a year with the family in order that their life balance is enhanced.
- (b): No such proposal has been made by CISF.

(c): Following number of Central Armed Police Forces (CAPFs) and Assam Refiles (AR) personnel (force-wise) have availed 100 days leave in a year from 2020 to till date:-
