COMPLAINTS PENDING WITH NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR SCHEDULED CASTES

- (a) whether it's a fact that over 47,000 complaints are pending with National Commission for Scheduled Castes;
- (b) if so, the reasons for the delay in taking action on complaints; and
- (c) the details of such complaints pending with NCSC, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) No, these complaints are active cases in which necessary actions, such as issuing notices, sending reminders, filing rejoinders or conducting hearings have already been undertaken. Furthermore, the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC) has initiated a special drive to expedite the resolution of these cases. As a result of these efforts, more than 18,000 cases have already been successfully disposed/closed by the present Commission.
