- (a) Jagannath temple at Puri, District Puri is a monument of national importance. The
- monument is maintained by Archaeological Survey of India and conserved based on the requirement to keep its originality.

From April 2022 till date 10 programs have been conducted by Eastern Zonal Cultural Centre (of which Odisha is a member state) in different parts of Odisha on Lord Jagannath Bhajan along with Odissi and Goutipua dance festival. Around 4000 audience have witnessed the festival and 180 artists benefitted from the program. Around Rs. 48 lakh has been spent in Odisha.
