Population of Asiatic lions

1174. SHRI SHAKTISINH GOHIL:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the population of Asiatic lions in the State of Gujarat;
- (b) the number of Asiatic lions that died in the State of Gujarat during the last three year;
- (c) the number of lions that died in accidents on railway tracks out of the total lions died; and
- (d) the steps being taken by Government to ensure that Asiatic lions do not leave the Gir reserve forest and farmers do not face any problems?

ANSWER

- (a) The population of Asiatic Lions was estimated to be 674 as per the last assessment conducted in the year 2020.
- (b) and (c) As informed by the State Government of Gujarat, 362 lions died during last three years in Gujarat out of which 7 lions died due to train accidents.
- (d) As informed by the State Government of Gujarat, the important management initiatives taken up as part of Asiatic Lion conservation include:
 - i. Increase in prey base for lions in the forest area
 - ii. Habitat protection interventions
 - iii. Providing waterholes at appropriate locations within forest area
 - iv. Radio collaring of selected lions for assessing their movement and behavior patterns.
 - v. Monitoring of movements of lions with support of trackers
 - vi. Provision for making payment of compensation to local people for cattle kills
 - vii. Erection of Machans in farm lands for farmers
 - viii. Construction of parapet walls around open wells
 - ix. Creation of awareness and training programme for farmers.
